TEAM DELEGATE

- · Nominate a team palmbeachtouch.com/play
- Have players register to your team and ensure no team members take the field that are not on the team sheet.

A loss of 1 try per player not registered

- Ensure all players are familiar with the conditions of entry and 8th edition rules.
- · Nominate a duty referee.
- Be responsible that all players in the team behave in an appropriate manner on and off the field before, during and after the game.
- · Invoice paid by Round 1
- Have all team members in correct uniform by Round 3

A loss of 1 try per player in incorrect uniform

- · Report any facility concerns to General Manager
- · Bring a game ball to the fields

COACHES

- · Must register online as a coach
- If any players in your team are under the age of 18, coaches must have a Qld Blue card or if a Teacher must have an 'exemption' card.

DUTY REFEREE

- All Teams MUST supply a duty referee for the competition with their nomination.
- All Referees are paid and receive a free drink
- All delegates will be contacted by the Referee Coordinator referees@palmbeachtouch.com

SENIOR PLAYERS

- All participants must complete online registration before they are to take the field palmbeachtouch.com/seniors
- Referees are instructed not to commence game unless all participants have registered online and in correct uniform,
- Each Participant will be required to sign on/check-in for their game each week. This verifies your attendance for Insurance.
- Participants must play/attend five (5) games to participate in finals. It is the responsibility of the team delegate to check all qualifications.
- · Support Team delegate with 'Duty Referee'
- Players requesting to change teams after registering to their current team must be done via admin@palmbeachtouch.com and will be reviewed on a case by case scenario. No player can change teams after 50% of the competition has been complete.

JUNIOR PLAYERS

- Parent/Guardian Nominates Child online and agrees to TFA, QTF & PBT Declarations
- Parent/Guardian of participants must be present at the venue
- Parent/Guardian must abide by all club & sport policies

FORFEITS

- Forfeits must be notified to Competition Coordinator by 10am the day of competition
- One forfeit without notice will see a \$50 repayment bond to be issued



Game Times

- **Seniors** Games are scheduled 20 minutes each way. 3 minute half time & 7 minutes between games.
- Senior Timeslots: 6:00pm / 6:50pm / 7:40pm / 8:30pm

Minimum Age & Divisions

- Seniors Although there is no set rule with a minimum age from TFA or QTF, Parents need to understand if they are entering their child into an adult competition, as a guide we recommend the minimum age of turning 14 by 31st December the year of the season played.
- Divisions Players are only allowed to play in 1 division of the registered competition.
 A player can not play Mens 3 and Mens 1
- Players under the age of 16 can play in a higher division for experience. Limit 2 per team.

Mutual Respect Policy

- Referees will be instructed to enforce zero tolerance rules regarding referee abuse from players, coaching staff and spectators.
- Teams/Players are bound by the Disciplinary
 Regulations Manual un-sportsman like behaviour eg
 sledging and or acting in an abusive manner towards
 the referee or opposing team.
- Teams/players/spectators that consume or introduce alcohol at the venue outside the laws associated with liquor license requirements will be asked to leave.

Competition Points

Win = 3 - Loss = 1 - Draw = 2 - Bye = 3 or 0*Forfeit Loss = 0 - Forfeit Win = 3

Insurance

 Any player injured at the venue is to report through to manager. Claim forms are available online at www.palmbeachtouch.com/insurance

Wet Weather

- We always have every intention to play. Always assume the games are on. Unless you see a social media post & receive an email it's off.
- We take our advice from GCCC ROU <u>WEBSITE</u> if the venue is Open or <u>Closed</u>. Normally updated between 2pm and 2:30pm.
- If fields are closed when the council updates come through, we notify via Facebook, Instagram and database notification email asap its off.
- If fields are open, and severe weather hits before or during, we will act accordingly, venue first, social media second, email third.

Forfeits & Late Starts

- It is the responsibility of each captain to report to the referees two minutes before the start of the game so the coin toss can be affected without loss of time.
- If a team is not at the field at the advertised starting time of the game, the attending team is awarded winning the toss.
- The offending team will receive a maximum of five (5) minutes from the commencement of the game (siren/whistle) to position the team on the field and be ready to commence play.
- If the offending team is not in attendance after the five
 (5) minutes has expired, the game will be deemed a forfeit win to the non offending team.
- If a team is late, one point may be awarded to the opposition team for every minute up to and including 5 points. Referee will determine allocated time.
- Any team that forfeits without notice more than once during the course of competition rounds WILL NOT be eligible for FINALS.



Forced Majeure

- If Palm Beach Touch are unable to perform, in whole or part in any obligation under these regulations of a Force Majeure Event, Palm Beach Touch is relieved of that obligation under these regulations to the extent, and the period it is unable to perform.
- In addition to this, Palm Beach Touch has no obligation to refund to any individual or team any fees paid if it is unable to perform by reason of a Force Majeure Event.
- FORCE MAJEURE EVENT: for the purposes of these regulations a force majeure event includes but is not limited to any or all of the following:
- Acts of God including flood, drought, earthquake, storm, cyclone, fire, explosion, epidemic; or
- · War or Act of Terrorism; or
- · Riot or civil disturbances; or
- Permanent injunction of any duly constituted court of competent jurisdiction; or
- Any fact, circumstance, matter or thing beyond the reasonable control of PBTA / TFA.

Lost & Found Policy

- All items found at the fields are subject to the following Lost & Found Policy
- Water Bottles Are available for collection for 7 days before thrown out
- Articles of Clothing Are available to the end of the season before donated to Salvation Army
- School Clothing donated to school at end of term
- Valuables such as but not limited to wallet, phone, watch, ipad, sunglasses will be handed in to Palm Beach Police station for collection no later then 48 hours after being found

Blood Bin

- Any player with a bleeding cut or abrasion is to leave the field immediately and have the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered. At this time, any blood stained clothing must also be either cleaned or replaced.
- If the player does not leave the field immediately, the Referee will stop the game and ask the player to leave the field (normal substitution rules apply).
- Once the flow of blood has been stemmed, the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered and any blood stained clothing and equipment cleaned or replaced, the player may return to the field and continue play. If bleeding cannot be controlled and the wound securely covered, the player must not continue in the game

Protest

- Protests will be heard and determined by the Judiciary and or designated Protest Committee. The Competition Committee will form the Protest Committee. It will include at least three committee members or persons designated by the committee.
- Protests must be lodged in writing within twenty (20)
 minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, to
 the Competition Manager or to an official designated by
 the Competition Manager.
- The protest is to be lodged and signed by the Team Manager or their nominated representative.
- The protest will then be investigated by the Protest Committee. The Team Manager or their nominated representative will be notified of the decision.
- Any notice to be served on any person to attend a hearing, will be served on the Team Manager or nominated representative of the team involved, and any such service is deemed to be served on all parties or persons under the control of that Team Manager or their nominated representative


