TEAM DELEGATE RESPONSIBILITIES



TEAM DELEGATE - \$0 PER TEAM

- Nominate Team via palmbeachtouch.com
- Send Link to players to register online
- Choose Team Fee or Individual Fee



MINIMUM PLAYERS PER TEAM

- All teams must have a minimum of 8 players per team
- Teams below this number are removed from the draw
- All teams we recommend a minimum of 10 players per team



ONLY ALLOW REGISTERED PLAYERS TO PLAY

- Ensure no team members take the field that are not on the team sheet
- Teams that play unregistered players may forfeit competition points



HAVE ALL PLAYERS IN SAME UNIFORM

- All players must be in team uniform by Round 3 (singlet/shirt)
- A loss of 1 try per player for incorrect uniform



BE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR TEAM

- All players abide by competition, state and national policies
- Players have mutual respect and behaviour in appropriate manner



ASSIT THE CLUB

- **Encourage any players to become a referees** to help support our club and the game of Touch, All referees are paid
- Report and facility concerns to the Competition Coordinator



GAME NIGHT

- Keep in contact with your team (competition updates, times etc)
- Bring a game ball to the field
- If you need to forfeit, notify the club before midday of competition

Divisions

- **Mixed** Maximum male players on the field at any one time is 3 & minimum is 1
- **Divisions** - Players are only allowed to play in 1 division of the registered competition.
- **Players** - Can request to switch teams by written request and approved by committee, minimum games must be played to reach finals.
- **Divisions** - Can merge if nominations are below 6. Progression and Finals will be based on ladder standing.

Minimum Age

- **Opens** - For the **safety & welfare** of participants, **the minimum age is turning 13 by 31st December the year of the season played.**
- **Thursday Social** - Kids under this age can participate with their parents in the Thursday night Mixed C (Social Grade).
- **Under 16 Mixed** - the minimum age is turning 13 by 31st December the year of the season played.

Team Numbers

- **Maximum registrations per team is 20**
- **Maximum Team players per game is 14**
- Grand Final Prizes are capped at 14 player and are limited to how many players are registered to your team sheet
- i.e 11 players registered = 11 prizes

\$52 NATIONAL & STATE ANNUAL PLAYER REGISTRATION

- Charged on first registration of financial year (1st July to 30th June)
- This is NOT a Palm Beach Touch Fee
- \$22 is nationally recognised and covers you in every TFA affiliate
- \$30 is State recognised and covers you in every QTF affiliate

\$1,400 TEAM FEE MONDAY

\$1,300 TEAM FEE THURSDAY

- Free Ball if Invoice is paid on or before Team Delegate Meeting - Monday 28th July
- Receive invoice through Palm Beach Touch (xero)
- Bank details are on invoice for Netbank transfer

DON'T WANT TO COLLECT TEAM FEES?

- Nominate Team online
- Send team list (with email address to finance@palmbeachtouch.com)
- All players to register to team
- All players are emailed an invoice
- Anyone with outstanding invoice after Round 2 will forfeit game

NOMINATION AND REGISTRATION DATES

- Team Nominations close two (2) weeks prior to first round of competition.
- NO REFUNDS after Round 1 of competition.

Game Times

- Games are scheduled 20 minutes each way. 3 minute half time & 7 minutes between games.
- Timeslots: 6:00pm / 6:50pm / 7:40pm / 8:30pm

Competition Points

Win = 3 - Loss = 1 - Draw = 2 - Bye = 3

Forfeit Loss = 0 - Forfeit Win = 3

Wet Weather

- We always have every intention to play. Always assume the games are on. Unless you see a social media post & receive a database notification email asap its off.
- If fields are open, and severe weather hits before or during, we will communicate, venue 1st, social media 2nd, email 3rd.
- We take our advice from GCCC ROU WEBSITE if the venue is **Open** or **Closed**. Normally updated by 2:30pm.

Insurance

- If an injury occurs please notify referee and report to the competition coordinator to complete an injury report at the time of the incident.
- Unreported injuries at the time of the incident may not be accepted by insurance.
- If you'd like to make an insurance claim please reach out to the club via email: **competition@palmbeachtouch.com** for next steps.
- You can access claim forms and additional information via **www.palmbeachtouch.com/insurance** and it's encouraged to have completed within 30 days of the injury.

Forced Majeure

- If Palm Beach Touch are unable to perform, in whole or part in any obligation under these regulations of a Force Majeure Event, Palm Beach Touch is relieved of that obligation under these regulations to the extent, and the period it is unable to perform.
- In addition to this, Palm Beach Touch has no obligation to refund to any individual or team any fees paid if it is unable to perform by reason of a Force Majeure Event.
- FORCE MAJEURE EVENT: for the purposes of these regulations a force majeure event includes but is not limited to any or all of the following:
 - Acts of God including flood, drought, earthquake, storm, cyclone, fire, explosion, epidemic; or
 - War or Act of Terrorism; or
 - Riot or civil disturbances; or
 - Permanent injunction of any duly constituted court of competent jurisdiction; or
 - Any fact, circumstance, matter or thing beyond the reasonable control of PBTA/ TFA.

Blood Bin

- Any player with a bleeding cut or abrasion is to leave the field immediately and have the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered. At this time, any blood stained clothing must also be either cleaned or replaced.
- If the player does not leave the field immediately, the Referee will stop the game and ask the player to leave the field (normal substitution rules apply).
- Once the flow of blood has been stemmed, the cut or abrasion cleaned and covered and any blood stained clothing and equipment cleaned or replaced, the player may return to the field and continue play. If bleeding cannot be controlled and the wound securely covered, the player must not continue in the game

Forfeits & Late Starts

- If a team is not at the field at the time advertised of the game, the attending team is awarded winning the toss.
- If the offending team is not in attendance after the five (5) minutes has expired, the game will be deemed a forfeit win to the non offending team.
- If a team is late, one point may be awarded to the opposition team for every minute up to and including 5 points.
- Any team that forfeits without notice more than once during the course of competition rounds WILL NOT be eligible for FINALS.

Mutual Respect Policy

- Referees will be instructed to enforce zero tolerance rules regarding referee abuse from players, coaching staff and spectators.
- Players/Coaches and spectators are bound all TFA rules and policies.
- Teams/players/spectators that consume or introduce alcohol at the venue outside the laws associated with liquor license requirements will be asked to leave.

Protest

- Protests will be heard and determined by the General Manager, SQ Sport Manager or SQBD President. The Competition Committee will collect relevant information, requests, score cards, score sheets, referee reports, livestream footage (if paid protest)
- Protests must be lodged in writing by Team Delegate within twenty (20) minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, to the Competition Coordinator or to an official designated by PBT.
- The protest will then be investigated and the Team Manager or their nominated representative will be notified of the decision.
